



Isabella's Garden – This is the bug

For the craft activity, you will need

- Cardboard lid/a piece of cardboard from a fruit tray
- An egg box
- Wool, string, ribbon
- Scissors
- A toilet roll tube
- Strips of paper – coloured/magazine page/wrapping paper
- Glue
- Strips of coloured card

To make the Spider

- Take the body of the spider – the lid or the tray and make 8 holes around the edge
- Cut 8 equal lengths of string/wool/ribbon for the legs and one longer piece to hang the spider from.
- Thread a piece of you cord through a hole and tie a knot so it can't pull through and it dangles down
- Do the same for the other 7 legs
- Make a hole in the top and thread a longer piece of cord through to hang your spider by and tie a knot
- Cut out eight feet from the egg boxes, using the single egg holes
- Make a hole in each foot
- Thread one of the lengths of cord through the foot and tie another knot so it is secure and won't pull through
- Do this for each of the feet
- Draw 2 eyes on the body

You now have your spider - you can paint her if you like. Can you make her walk?
What is her name?



To make the bug

- Cut three strips of coloured paper, each long enough to wrap around the toilet tube
- Stick each piece around the tube as stripes on the body of your bug
- Make 2 holes either side of the tube
- Cut 4 lengths of wool/string/ribbon for the legs
- Thread each through a hole and tie a knot so it doesn't pull through
- Do the same for the other 3 legs
- Cut two short strips of card and stick them at one end for the bug's antennae
- Cut two small circles for the eyes and stick them on the end of the antennae

Now you have a bug – what will you call him ?
